






Dear Parents,

<p>In Mathematics we will be focusing on:</p> <p><b>Number:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Counting, reading and modelling numbers knowledge up to 100 and beyond</li> <li>Addition and Subtraction concepts</li> <li>Skip count by 2s, 5s, 10s</li> <li>Simple place value (hundreds, tens, ones)</li> </ul> <p><b>Measurement and Geometry:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Measure and compare the length of various objects</li> <li>Duration of time (days, weeks, months, years)</li> <li>tell the time to the half-hour</li> </ul> <p><b>Statistics and Probability:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Collecting, organising and displaying data</li> </ul> 	<p>In English we will be focusing on:</p> <p><b>Reading:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Predicting (what might the story be about? 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<p><b>Homework: Reading/ writing at home</b></p>	<p>Reading should be an enjoyable experience for all family members. Make this a special time where you and your child are not distracted. It is expected students will read a minimum of 5 times a week and the books be recorded in their reading log. Take home books are provided and children are also encouraged to borrow books from the school library. Please also make use of our local library. The 'Reading Log' book is to be returned every book changeover day for the teacher to check. Writing – please provide your child with writing materials, paper, glue and scissors to use at their leisure. Practise writing shopping lists, birthday cards or notes to friends.</p>																																			
<p><b>Nude food lunches</b></p> 	<p>All students are encouraged to bring 'nude food' lunches. A nude food lunch has no foil, gladwrap or any other packaging. Please unwrap and throw any rubbish out at home to help us significantly reduce the amount of rubbish scattered throughout our school. A labelled drink bottle containing water is highly encouraged. Nude food lunch boxes are available to purchase from our school office and most supermarkets have a range of options also.</p>																																			
<p><b>School Uniform</b></p>	<p>Our Beaumaris PS school uniform should be worn correctly and be in good condition. Please ensure all items of clothing are named and check the lost property cupboard near the art room for any missing items. Please ensure hair longer than shoulder length is tied up and hair accessories are school colours only. Jewellery is not part of the Beaumaris PS school uniform including coloured wrist and ankle bands. Students may only wear small stud earrings. School uniform is worn on excursions. All students will require a school hat to wear outside until second Term.</p>
